Downtown Attractions:

- **Staples Center** – Hosts LA sports teams, as well as concerts.
- **LA Live** – sports and entertainment complex that features popular dining venues, Regal Cinemas movie theatre, Lucky Strike Bowling Lanes, the interactive Grammy Museum, ESPN Zone, the Conga Room and the Nokia Theater. Located next to Staples Center
- **REDCAT, Walt Disney Concert Hall, and the Music Center**, which encompasses the Ahmanson Theatre, Mark Taper Forum and Dorothy Chandler Pavilion. All present live music and theater performances, including nationally – touring theater productions and the Los Angeles Philharmonic.
- **Fig at 7th** – Shopping and Dining.
- **Little Tokyo** – Shopping and Dining.
- **Museum of Contemporary Art (MOCA)** features one of the country's most prolific permanent collections of art create after 1940, and presents ongoing exhibitions.
- **Dodger Stadium** – home of the Los Angeles Dodgers MLB baseball team
